Our work this term will include...

This term's topic is 'Diversity'.

In Literacy, Language and Communication we will be learning the skills of letter and diary writing as well as chronological and non-chronological report writing. For Welsh Week we will be focusing on Welsh poetry writing. In Welsh we will be focusing on the topic 'Bwyd ac Partis' (Food and Parties.)

In Mathematics and Numeracy, we will be focusing on the areas of presenting data with line graphs, analogue and digital time, reading and understanding timetables. Also, we will be covering the measuring of distance and mass. Throughout the term will be focusing on addition/subtraction/ multiplication/division and the eleven times table. In Science and Technology, we will be investigating what causes bread to go mouldy and learning about human and animal skeletons. In Technology we will be creating a tent design using Tinkercad, creating databases, learning how to make a website using Google Sites and celebrating STEM Week and Internet Safety Day.

In Humanities we will be comparing Wales with other countries. We will also be looking at different religious Springtime celebrations.

In Expressive Arts our focus will be on contrasting colours and using them to create animal pictures that are significant to cultures within our Year group. We will then turn these into 3D models. For Music, we will be appraising folk music and creating a piece of music using GarageBand to complement our artwork. For Health and Well-being, we will be looking at 'Dreams and Goals' and 'Healthy Me'. In PE we will be
